Partner Updates

UC ANR and UC Davis are conducting a survey of consumers to identify which types of specialty Asian produce are almost always cooked before eating, so that Southeast Asian and other small-scale farmers can receive exemptions from federal food safety regulations for low-risk crops.

Practical Farmers of Iowa are on track to host 60 virtual field days in 2020 and have learned a lot along the way. The presentation covered common planning challenges, equipment

considerations, best practices and tips learned so far, and outline the technical behind-thescenes steps necessary to pull the event off.

Farmer Outreach Coordinator Maggie Norton shared all about this during <u>"Virtual Field Days: How-to & Best Practices Webinar."</u>

MOSES, GrassWorks, Iowa Organic Association, OGRAIN, the University of Wisconsin, and Fairshare CSA Coalition are sponsoring a 5-in-1 virtual event. **Growing Stronger: Collaborative Conference on Organic & Sustainable Farming** will take place online Feb. 22-27, 2021. Registration opens Dec. 1, 2020. Admission will be \$125, with a \$25 discount through December.

NECAFS is pleased to announce the release of an educational resource for farmers and food producers. The new website answers <u>key legal questions</u> about the FSMA PSR. NECAFS and the Center for Agriculture and Food Systems at Vermont Law School (CAFS) worked together to research commonly asked FSMA Produce Safety Rule legal questions and create educational resources that provide clarity and understanding for our audience.

The University of Minnesota is hosting On-Farm Food Safety webinars this winter, led by farmer-trainers and Extension educators. The next one happens December 17.

Researchers from Virginia Tech and North Carolina State University are assessing the impact of COVID-19 on farmers markets nationwide. They are seeking input from farmers' market managers and vendors on business practices implemented in response to COVID-19. They hope to use this data from this survey to better understand how resources can be developed for these groups.

Federal Updates

FDA Extends Comment Deadline to Submit Information on Expansion of the Rarely Consumed Raw List for Uncommonly Consumed Produce

To assist stakeholders in understanding this new Food Traceability proposal, the FDA is making a number of additional resources available.

A video recording of the October 26th webinar on the First 100 Days of the New Era of Smarter

Food Safety is now available. During this one-hour webinar, Deputy Commissioner Frank Yiannas and leaders of teams working on the four Core Elements of the New Era blueprint discuss the new approach FDA is taking to food safety, leveraging technology and other tools to create a safer and more digital, traceable food system.

An additional resource is a <u>tool</u> designed to allow users to explore the results of the Risk-Ranking Model for Food Tracing used in the development of the Food Traceability List.

Produce Safety Alliance remote training updates

The NCR will cover the cost of PSA manuals and AFDO certificates for collaborative remote trainings (up to 10 participants per state). We're defining "collaborative" as a training where trainers from 2 or more states work together to plan and lead the event (not a training that one state hosts and a grower from another state happens to register for). Money is available until it has all been requested. Trainer sharing money is still available for trainings targeting one state.
