Mini-grants



The NCR FSMA Center is re-budgeting funds into mini-grants in light of the Coronavirus pandemic. Funds are largely available for service honorarium and travel funds to help meet 1 of 3 center objectives as outlined under "Project Initiatives" listed on the website. Complete items under "Proposal" and submit to Ellen by February 14. Proposals will be accepted after February 14 but probably won't be included in the first round of funding. Because

New Resources

Back in 2017 Chris Blanchard and Dr. Erin Silva received funding from NIFA to create a series of podcasts on farm food safety. If you knew Chris, you'll be aware that he passed away late in 2018 and was unable to finish the project.

The team regrouped and brought on board Harriet Behar (UW-Madison) and Annalisa Hultberg (U of MN State Food Safety Educator) to complete the project. They are happy to report that the podcasts have turned out well and are now available for listening.

The series is temporarily available from the Silva Lab website. When this changes to a permanent location, we will update our website.

FDA Updates

The FDA has made two updates to its materials for stakeholders regarding the proposed rule, "Requirements for Additional Traceability Records for Certain Foods" (Food Traceability Proposed Rule). The FDA is proposing to establish additional traceability recordkeeping requirements (beyond what is already required in existing regulations) for persons who manufacture, process, pack, or hold foods the Agency has designated for inclusion on the Food Traceability List.



The U.S. Food and Drug Administration is extending the comment period for the proposed rule entitled "Requirements for Additional Traceability Records for Certain Foods" and reopening the comment period for the information collection provisions until February 22, 2021.

Partner Events

Registration is open for the <u>Food Safety Outreach Program (FSOP) Roundtable Webinar</u> on Feb. 4. Eight awardees from around the country will be presenting on their work.

The virtual 2021 Consumer Food Safety Education Conference will happen March 10-12, 2021. Graduate and undergraduate students studying food safety, food microbiology, public health or environmental health at a US-based university are eligible to apply for a scholarship. The deadline for submission is February 18, 2021.

The National Farmers Union is hosting a webinar for produce safety educators, <u>Stories from the field</u>: Small Farms and GAP Audits, on Monday Feb 22, from 2:00 PM – 3:00 pm EST.

The <u>5-in-1 Organic Conference</u> will be held Feb. 22-26. MOSES (Midwest Organic & Sustainable Education Service), GrassWorks, Iowa Organic Association, OGRAIN (Organic Grain Resource and Information Network), and FairShare CSA Coalition & University of Wisconsin Extension are all collaborating for this virtual conference.

Struggling with cleaning and sanitizing practices? You're not alone. You asked, we listened, and now we have a few follow-up questions... Partners at the University of Vermont, Cornell University, USDA, and National Farmers Union Foundation are working together to develop a new training program to help small and medium-scale farmers take their businesses to the next level of safe and efficient vegetable handling systems. Michigan State University Extension is offering an online <u>course for farm supervisors</u>. It begins February 8.

Funding Available

<u>Funds are available</u> to help NCR partners (anyone who participates in NCR activities) attend virtual trainings/events. Under most circumstances, the NCR will reimburse you after the event for the registration fee.

The mentoring program and the trainer sharing program also have funding available.

The NCR will cover the cost of PSA manuals and AFDO certificates for collaborative remote trainings. Money is available until it has all been requested. Not every state will be using the money designated for their growers, so please contact Ellen if you'd like to submit additional receipts.

Food Safety Outreach Grants The RFA is out and the due date is April 1, 2021. The Food Safety Outreach Program will complement and expand the national infrastructure of the National Food Safety Training, Education, Extension, Outreach, and Technical Assistance Competitive Grants Program.
