

Knowledge Assessments Released



Between July 1, 2020, and June 30, 2021, NCR FSMA partners offered and evaluated 52 PSA Grower Trainings. Of these trainings, 30 were offered using remote delivery, because of the COVID-19 pandemic. In collaboration with partners, the NCR FSMA evaluated these trainings using a knowledge assessment.

The report sharing the results from trainings held in year 4 (2020-21) was just released. Year 4 saw a proliferation of multi-state trainings, when NCR FSMA partners jointly taught remote trainings. Knowledge assessment results showed that knowledge gained from remote delivery trainings was higher than face-to-face trainings. Read the regional report. FDA Updates

The FDA will host a <u>virtual summit</u> October 19-21, 2021, for a discussion and exchange of perspectives about the safety of human and animal foods produced, manufactured, sold, and delivered directly to consumers through e-commerce. Summit participants will discuss the regulatory framework that apply to these foods and ways to strengthen food safety.

FDA and Mexican counterparts report progress and next steps for food safety partnership, according to Frank Yiannis. The two countries held their first <u>Food Safety Partnership Annual Meeting</u> on August 20, 2021.

FAO Update

The Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations recently released <u>updated</u> <u>guidance</u> to highlight additional measures that food businesses and the authorities regulating the sector can take to protect workers from person-to-person spread of COVID-19. While COVID-19 may pose an occupational safety risk for workers in any type of business or industry where individuals work in close proximity to one another, SARS-CoV-2 itself is not considered a direct food safety hazard.

Evening Produce Safety Alliance training?

The **University of Georgia** is hiring a <u>program coordinator</u> to provide technical assistance to



Food Science and Technology Extension faculty. The position will be housed in the Food Science Building at the Athens, GA campus. Responsibilities include the development and review of food product classifications, process approvals, nutrition fact panels, and food safety plans for food processors, packinghouses, and farm. The program coordinator II will also offer laboratory-based support for the food industry.

The **University of Arkansas**, Local, Regional and Safe Foods Team is hiring a <u>Post-Doc</u> who will lead education and on-farm technical assistance for produce growers, stakeholders, and county agents in the FSMA Produce Safety Rule or Preventive Controls training and other related food safety training. PSA trainer or lead trainer certification preferred.

They are also hiring a <u>Program Associate</u> in Food Systems and Food Safety to identify, enroll, and train produce growers, stakeholders, and county agents in the FSMA Produce Safety Rule training and other related food safety training. PSA trainer certification preferred.
