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Peer to Peer Mentorship Program

- Program designed to assist with fostering a professional relationship with a fellow food safety educator.
- Produce focused food safety educators within the NCR whose job is to assist with the implementation of a food safety regulations

HOW DOES THIS PROGRAM WORK?

1. Complete an application available on ncrfsma.org website.
2. Match with peer will be provided by NCR FSMA Center
3. Attend a virtual pre-program webinar and complete evaluation.
4. Meet virtually with your peer match and establish goal(s) for the mentorship.
5. \$500 travel stipends available per pair

Educator Sharing Program

- Funding to support sending a lead trainer of the Produce Safety Alliance grower training, Preventive Controls Human Food training, or other food safety certified program training in the absence of lead trainers.
- Anyone in the NCR providing a regional-based food safety certified program training

HOW DOES THIS PROGRAM WORK?

1. Determine the date or date range that a lead trainer is needed for a course.
2. Identify a lead trainer or ask NCR FSMA Center to identify a trainer.
3. Determine the cost for the travel for the confirmed trainer.
4. Gain approval for travel funds for the trainer from NCR FSMA Center.
5. \$500 travel stipends available
